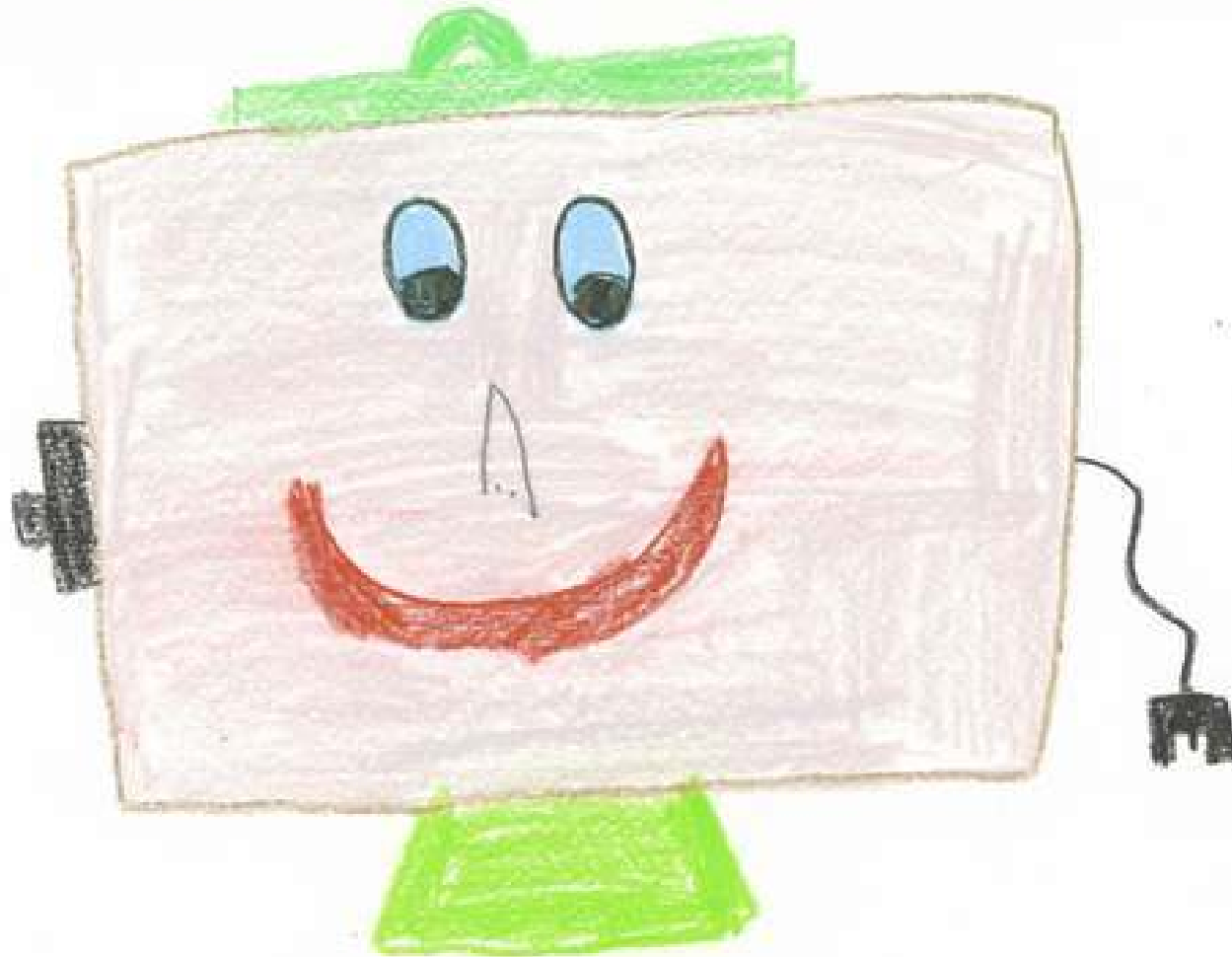

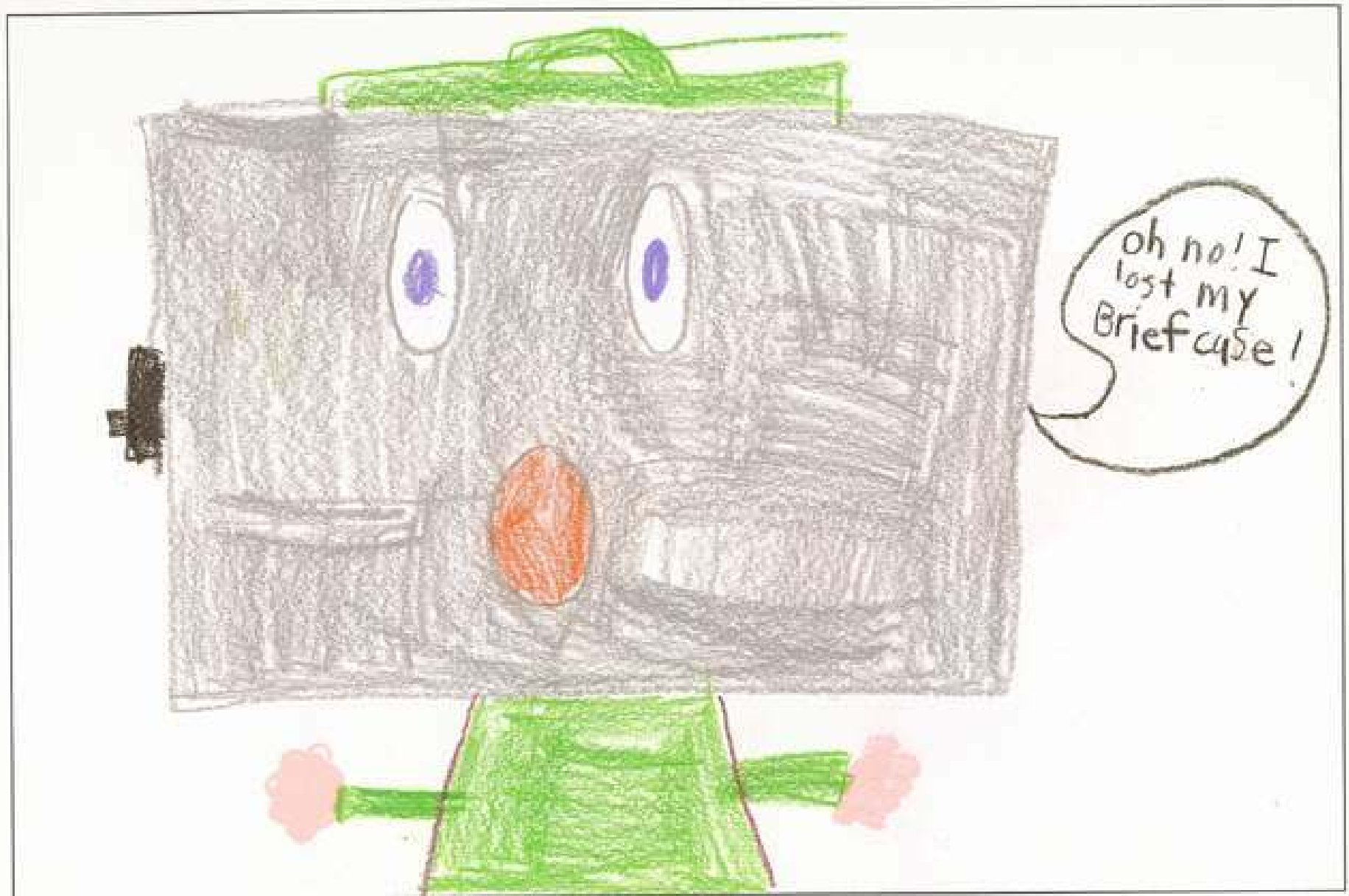

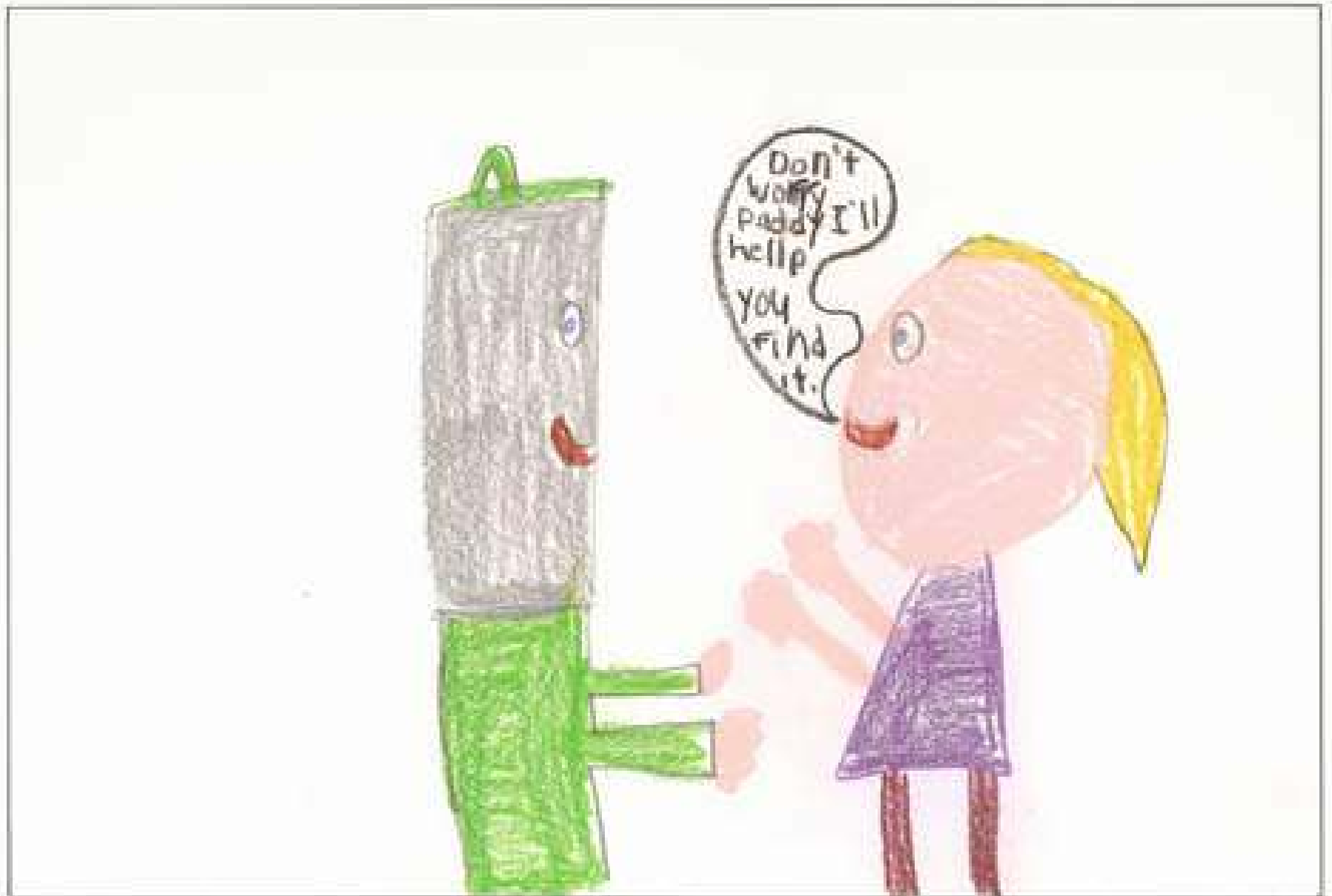
Toasterman lives in Bakeryville with his wife, Sarah, and his daughter, Marmalade.
He works as a traveling toaster.



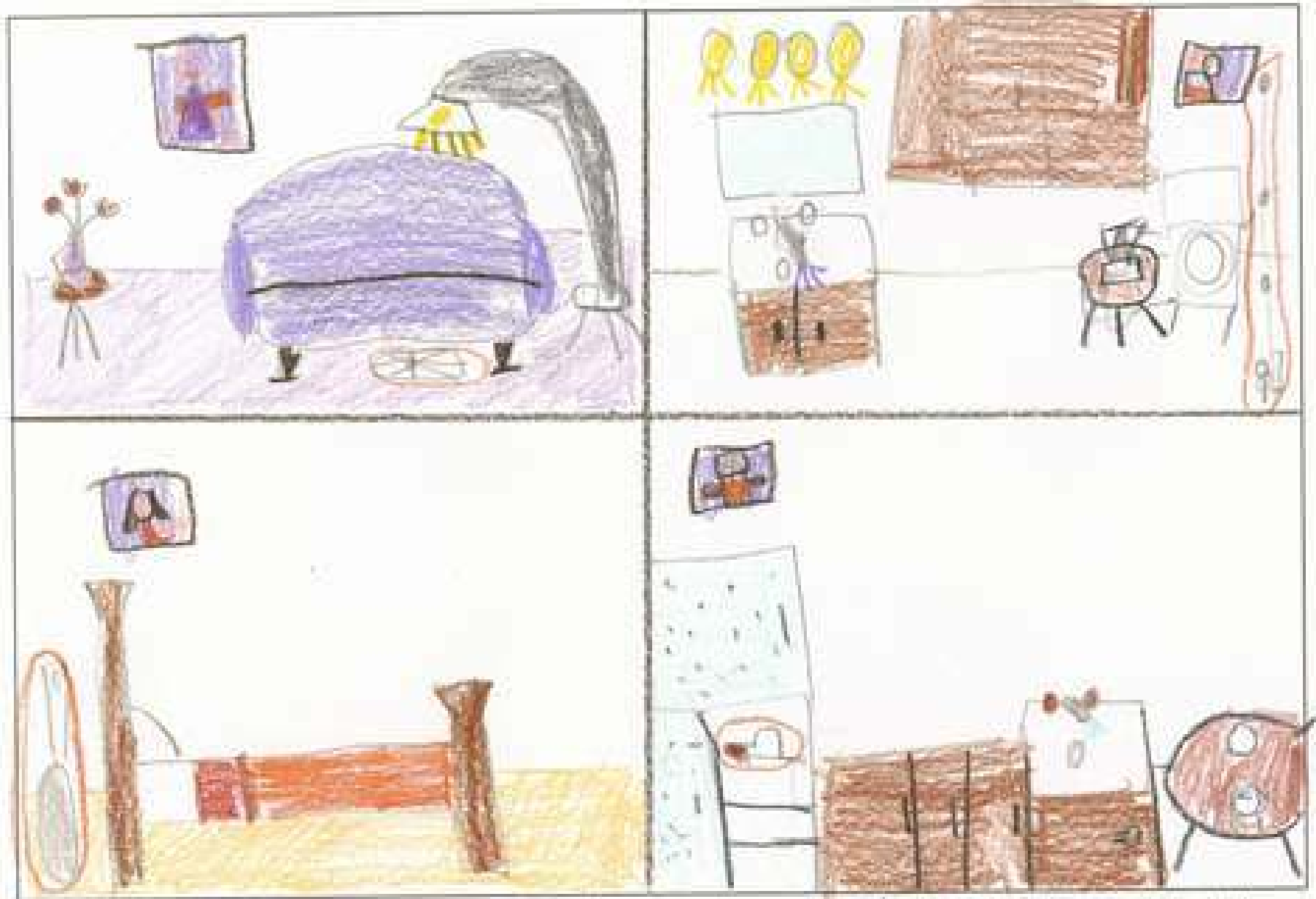
He carries around bread and butter in his briefcase. His wife makes excellent jelly.
